IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS AFTER THE EXECUTION OF YOUR WILL

Wills are not meant to be executed and then forgotten. You should review your Will yourself at least annually to make sure that the Will carries out your wishes as to the disposition of your property. In addition, since laws and regulations change frequently, you should have your Will reviewed by an attorney on a regular basis to make sure that your estate plan is in conformity with your current asset situation and to ascertain whether changes in law warrant Will revisions.

Furthermore, changes in your financial condition and changes in your family situation (such as death of a family member or birth of a child) should warrant a Will review immediately. Certain family events (such as divorce or marriage) will revoke your Will, and thus mandate that a new Will be executed.

If you wish to make any changes in your Will in the future, these changes must be made with the same formalities as were used in executing your present Will. Therefore, do not attempt to make any changes in your Will yourself. Should you wish to make a change, please contact an attorney. Changes can often be made with a rather short document known as a codicil.
